Changes

We have made a number of changes to improve our service to you. You may already have noticed a number of these.

You will now find all of the forms you need for interacting with us on the contact page of the website. It speeds things up if you use the correct one. You should get a "Success" screen after you submit it so you know we have got it.

If you need to send us an item it cannot be attached to an email. Please fax it or post it to us.

The Treatment Review Form now asks that you provide details of all medical conditions and medications you have and asks whether you are seeing any other mental health specialist. It is important that your care is properly co-ordinated.

After renewing a script for you, or following an appointment, you will get a summary letter from us. This comes via an encrypted messaging service. Please distribute to your GP, and other medical or mental health professionals involved in your care or anyone else you deem should have it. We are doing things this way because your details lodged with us following your initial referral are more often than not out of date. More importantly it puts you in charge of your data ensuring that only those people you want to have it, actually do so. Please bear in mind that for your safety all key individuals should be aware of the medication you are on as there are some key interactions especially for those with cardiac conditions and eating disorders.

When you renew your script we automatically check the States Data Base (Scriptcheck). This lists all Schedule 4 and 8 medications prescribed to you by doctors in WA. This should match your declaration on your TRF. If you have been prescribed these medications (even for a short period), since your previous renewal, let us know even if you have then ceased them or never took them (which you can explain on the form). If there is a discrepancy we will require you to have an appointment to clarify what is happening.

If there is any key change to your health the involved doctor should write to us to keep us up to date so we can co-ordinate your care. Again they can post or fax their report to us.
